Housekeeping

- Church Council decided that the time has come to keep the main front doors closed to maximise the heat in the church. Entry and exit will be via the glazed link. However we will have the main gates open to welcome people in and a welcome notice is displayed on the main doors. The church heating comes on at 2.00am to heat the sanctuary but if entry doors are left open it soon cools down!!! Should you be cold during the service some blankets are available adjacent to the organ.

- If you see something that needs doing (i.e. more toilet rolls needed or new kitchen supplies required, towels to be washed etc) feel free to take action and rectify the situation.
